This introductory course equips you with knowledge and skills for entry into an apprenticeship (Certificate III in Plumbing) providing a specific range of foundational plumbing techniques.

You will learn

- Working safely as part of a team
- Measuring and calculating
- Using basic industry terminology to communicate effectively
- Reading plans and specifications
- Selecting and using plumbing tools, equipment, and materials
- Producing simple technical drawings
- Using basic welding equipment
- Using plumbing pipes, fittings, and fixtures to simulate plumbing installations

Structured Workplace Learning


